

## PRIMARY SCHOOL PE AND SPORT FUNDING



2013-2014

The Primary School PE and Sport Funding for 2013-2014 is £9 215.

### Aims of spending:

- To hire specialist P.E. teachers or qualified sports coaches to work alongside our teachers when teaching P.E.
- To launch new or additional sports clubs.
- To pay for professional development opportunities in P.E.
- To provide cover to release our teachers for professional development in P.E.
- To run sports competitions, increasing participation.

Our money has been allocated as follows:

However, it must be noted that our school spends more than the above amount on Primary School PE and Sport. During 2013-2014 coaches from SAFC Foundation have been spending one day per week in school delivering football coaching sessions across school (£1500 per term). This is funded from our main school budget.

### Measuring the Impact:

Our teachers work alongside the coaches, who provide professional development opportunities within our own school. Teachers complete evaluations identifying what progress their children have made during the sessions. They also identify what they have learned, which will make them better teachers of Primary Sport and PE.
